**CV R-TAC Leadership Series** 



During a Bright Spot visit, Community Schools grantees observed how <u>Fort</u>

<u>Miller Middle School</u> is bringing Community Schools strategies to life. With 94% of students socioeconomically disadvantaged, including English learners, students with disabilities, and foster/homeless youth, Fort Miller prioritizes relationships, recognition, and responsive systems. Fort Miller's focus on family engagement, attendance monitoring, and strong community partnerships has led to 93% staff satisfaction, 98% retention and a reduction in chronic absenteeism. Their success highlights the power of intentional community-

building, restorative practices, and student-centered support in transforming

school culture and outcomes.

On November 19, **Norseman Elementary** hosted a "Bright Spot" visit, offering CCSPP grantees an in-depth look at their Community Schools journey. Co-facilitated by Principal Kevin Her and Community Schools Coordinator Rima Maldonado, the presentation highlighted key strategies, including collaborative leadership, integrated student supports, and strong family engagement. Attendees explored Norseman's holistic approach, which includes dedicated community spaces, strategic partnerships, and enhanced academic and social-emotional initiatives. This visit showcased the transformative impact of Community Schools in fostering student success









## **EMPOWERING FAMILIES WITH SCHOOL DATA**

This week, the Stanislaus County Office of Education's **Cradle to Career (C2C)** division hosted a California School Dashboard workshop with parents, students, community leaders, and school staff. In collaboration with **StanYEA** (Youth Empowerment Alliance), **StanC2C**, and the Parent Network, C2C co-facilitated this learning opportunity, exemplifying collaborative leadership in action. Participants engaged in hands-on activities, including a data scavenger hunt and data huddles, to explore school performance metrics, identify strengths, and discuss areas for growth. The interactive workshop fostered meaningful discussions and empowered attendees with the knowledge and tools to advocate for positive change. Feedback from participants highlighted the experience as empowering, informative, engaging, and fun, reinforcing the value of community-driven learning.
