TAFT UNION HIGH SCHOOL - EXCELLENCE BY DESIGN

Taft Union High School is utilizing part of their Community Schools grant to add school social workers at each high school. Taft Union High School's social worker is Deflina Duarte, and **Buena Vista High School**'s social worker is Sonya Adams. Together they are working on family engagement, connecting families to vital resources such as food, clothing, assistance with childcare and housing, removing barriers students are facing, individual and group counseling, and many more activities to help students be ready to learn.

One example is **The Panther Closet**. The Panther Closet, an initiative at BVHS High School, provides essential resources like toiletries, clothing, and snacks for students in need. Developed by social worker Sonya Adams and school counselor David Ahumada, it addresses the challenges faced by students from socio-economic backgrounds. Funded by anonymous donors and matched by Chevron, the Closet aims to boost student confidence, health, and academic focus. Located in Sonya's office, it creates an inclusive environment for all students.
