Panama-Buena Vista Union School District: Strength Through Collaboration

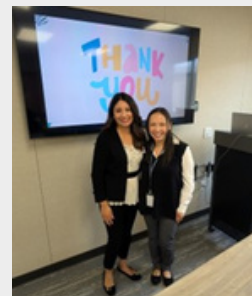
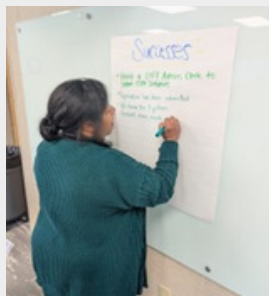
During a recent meeting of the **Panama-Buena Vista Union School District's** Community School Advisory Council, four site teams—composed of administrators, teachers, and support staff—came together to reflect on this year's Annual Progress Report. The session highlighted the strength of collaboration and the importance of shared purpose across roles and campuses.



As teams engaged with reflective questions, exchanging insights and celebrating progress, one teacher's comment stood out: "I know all of the four pillars!" This brief statement underscored the deeper significance of the work.

It represented more than familiarity with a framework—it reflected the impact of sustained professional learning, alignment, and a sense of collective ownership across the community school teams.

Such moments affirm the power of a unified vision. When all members of a school community understand and support the foundational pillars of the community school model, alignment strengthens, collaboration deepens, and student-centered strategies take root.

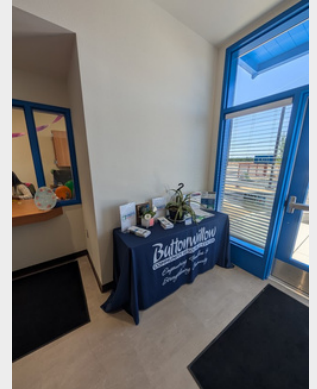


This is the work of community schools:

ROOTED IN CARE: THE BUTTONWILLOW FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER OPENS ITS DOORS

The new **Buttonwillow Family Resource Center** offers essential services families often struggle to access—**emergency food and clothing, legal and tax support, job placement help, welfare guidance, vision and dental care, and parent training** for children ages zero to three. This expanded facility gives families a larger, safer, and more private space to receive support. It also includes confidential rooms where students can attend health or speech appointments—whether in person or online—without leaving campus. This new center is more than a building—it's a promise to meet families with dignity, care, and the support they deserve. It stands as a shining example of what's possible when community schools bring resources and relationships together in one place.
